I am a new teacher to Collierville Schools; however, I am not new to the profession. Therefore, I was not required to have informal observations by the instructional coaches. In the future, questions about informal observations need to have a (NA) response choice.

I am a new teacher to Collierville but not a new teacher. For me, the trainings weren't particularly beneficial but only because I don't have a classroom, I'm at the middle and high schools. Maybe though, instead of putting all new people together, you could divide it into brand new teachers and those who are new to the system but not new as teachers. I think the training would look different for each group.

We need a school-wide policy book that can be used as a reference source. There are MANY acronyms that are commonly used but are not necessarily known to new teachers.

This is a great and very well organized program.

Note: Support Team Leaders are leaders in the building with a focus on teacher growth and student achievement. Professionalism, confidentiality, and strong work ethic are expected at all times. Support Team Leaders may be asked to relinquish his/her position if not satisfactorily meeting expectations, at which time no stipend will be paid.

#### **Teacher Leaders**

**Approximately 103 teachers will serve in teacher leader positions during the 2016-2017 school year to support district initiatives and goals.**

#### **Teacher Leader Eligibility Requirements**

Educators serving as Teacher Leaders will be identified based on, but not limited to the following:

- o TEAM evaluation scores/reinforcement areas
- o Student achievement
- o Curriculum expertise and experience
- o Technology expertise and experience
- o Leadership skills

- o Teachers representatives selected to lead school/district programs
- o Recommendations by school and/or district administrators

Works effectively with teachers, principal and district leaders

Works collaboratively with the School Support Team members

Possesses strong relationship, leadership, and instructional skills

Embraces a growth mindset for themselves, colleagues, and students

Maintains confidentiality

### **Teacher Leader Responsibilities**

Attend school/district/state trainings per district request

Redeliver trainings as deemed necessary

Collaborate with school and district administrators to identify school needs

Maintain a model classroom for scheduled teacher visits

Share best practices by way of video recording, resources, peer observations, and professional development sessions

Design and facilitate professional development sessions to support school/district goals

Submit activity proposals and documentation for all professional development and support sessions

### **Teacher Leader Stipends**

Teacher Leaders are eligible to receive a stipend for the responsibilities outlined above.

Stipends will be based on a predetermined rate per session, which requires a minimum number of documented hours within the Teacher Leader role.

Stipends will be disbursed after the school year is completed

1 An unmanned aircraft system (Drone) means a powered, aerial vehicle that:

- 3 1. Does not carry a human operator and is operated without the possibility of direct human
- 4 intervention from within or on the aircraft;
- 5
- 6 2. Uses aerodynamic forces to provide vehicle lift;
- 7
- 8 3. Can fly autonomously or be piloted remotely; and
- 9
- 10 4. Can be expendable or recoverable.<sup>1</sup>

## 11 **Appropriate Use**

12 Visitors and unsupervised students are prohibited from operating drones on district property without  
13 prior written approval of the Superintendent or Designee. District personnel are authorized to use aerial  
14 drones, with appropriate training and approval from Superintendent, Designee, and/or Principal.

15  
16  
17 Staff members, students, coaches, sponsors, or parents representing the district or any of its affiliated  
18 clubs shall operate any and all district aerial drones in accordance with this policy and all applicable  
19 Federal Aviation laws and regulations such as the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012.<sup>2</sup> This  
20 includes any additional certifications or authorizations that may be required from the Federal Aviation  
21 Administration based on the drone's intended use.<sup>3</sup>

22 The following guidelines must be adhered to by anyone flying a drone on district property:

- 23 1. All drones operating on district property must weigh no more than 55 lbs.
- 24 2. Operators must not operate a drone within five (5) miles of any airport without prior
- 25 notification and confirmation from airport authorities.
- 26 3. Operators must not operate a drone above an altitude of 400 feet above ground level and
- 27 remain clear of surrounding obstacles.
- 28 4. Operators must maintain safe control and line of sight with the drone during all stages
- 29 of operation.
- 30 5. Operators must maintain a safe operating distance from crowds and ensure drone
- 31 operations do not interfere with manned aircraft operations.

- 1           6.     Data collected by a drone can only be used for hobby (educational) purposes and may
- 2                     not be sold for profit.
- 3           7.     If there is a plan to fly drones over property that is not owned by the district, the
- 4                     director of schools shall first obtain written permission from the owner of the property
- 5                     at issue. District personnel operating drones on property not owned by the district must
- 6                     adhere to all requirements of this policy.<sup>3</sup>
- 7           8.     Operators assumes all risk damage to property and bodily injuries that may occur due to
- 8                     unsafe operation of district owned drones.

10 *Inappropriate Use*

11  
12 Inappropriate use of drones includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- 13
- 14           1.     Violating any local, state, or federal statutes or regulations;
- 15
- 16           2.     Taking pictures of property or persons without consent;<sup>4</sup>
- 17
- 18           3.     Violating safe operating protocols as defined in drone user manual and classroom
- 19                     guidelines;
- 20
- 21           4.     Failing to follow a district policy while using the district’s drone technology or failing
- 22                     to follow any other policies or guidelines established by district administrators or their
- 23                     designees; and
- 24
- 25           5.     Harassing, defined as persistently annoying of another, interfering with another’s work,
- 26                     insulting, or attacking others.

27 *Violations*

28 District staff shall monitor for inappropriate use of district drone technology as defined by this policy.  
29 Violators may be subject to disciplinary action, up to an including suspension and/or expulsion for  
30 students or suspension and/or termination for employees.
