- Updates and reminders will be put into place so that board members can participate in the many student activities planned.

Mr. Goforth, Academics:

- Science Textbook Adoption:
 - ACS will participate with school districts across the state in the adoption process.
 - Principals have nominated representatives from their school to be on the adoption committee.
 - The committee slate will be presented at the October board meeting for approval per policy.
- Mandated Tutoring:
 - State-mandated tutoring is for any student retained in K-3 and 4th graders who must have it as part of their promotional pathway per the state literacy law. Mandated tutoring takes place during the school day.
 - We also provide before/after school tutoring for grades 3-5.
 - The PAWS reading program will continue in partnership with Arlington Senior Center, allowing their volunteers to support our early learners (K-2).
 - 14 students that are transitioning from 3rd to 4th grade that were approaching on TCAP and require tutoring as their promotional pathway.
 - State law now requires any retained student in K-2 to receive tutoring.
- LEAD Arlington:
 - Continues in partnership with the Town of Arlington and the Chamber of Commerce.
 - LEAD is a collaboration of the community, town and schools.
 - LEAD serves as a great support and requirement for the Arlington Collegiate Academy students.
